To qualify for rebates:
♦ A load management control must be installed.

Line Extension Fees

Riverland Energy requires \$500 new construction fee, which covers the first 250 feet of line.

Distances 250' - 800"	\$6.50/ft.
Over 800 ft.	\$5.00/ft.


Upon installation of an 80 gallon electric water heater and load management control, \$150 of the new construction fee will be refunded. Upon installation of a central air conditioner and load management control, \$25 will be refunded.

Programs & Rebates

Energy Star Program

Riverland Energy offers rebates when you buy an appliance or lighting with the ENERGY STAR® label. To qualify for a rebate, eligible appliance models and lighting must be installed within the REC service area. To receive your rebate, cut out the ENERGY STAR® label on the product, attach it to the completed rebate form along with a detailed and legible copy of the receipt.

Water Heater Program

Riverland Energy offers rebates for the installation of electric hot water heaters. The installation will be inspected by the Riverland Energy load management department and a load management control must be installed. A copy of the receipt is required.

Central Air and Heat Pump Programs

Riverland's heat pump program and air conditioning program was created in the spirit of reducing member's overall space heating and cooling energy costs.

♦ A controlled central air conditioner qualifies for a \$5.00 monthly credit in June, July, August & September.

Heat Pump

Air-to-Air (14 SEER or greater)	\$120/ton
Geothermal	\$200/ton

Dual Fuel Program

Riverland Energy offers an off-peak heating/cooling program to provide the heat requirements for a building with an off-peak electric heating system, except during Peak Times when the back up system takes over. With the dual fuel program, two meters are required. Any form of electric heat, heat pump, and the electric water heater may be put on the dual fuel meter - billed at a substantial savings compared to the regular rate. Riverland Energy can provide the double meter socket for \$100.
