Regional grid challenges affecting reliability; follow peak alert and energy emergency notices

When Riverland Energy is approaching a period when energy use is expected to be very high, we'll issue a "Peak Alert". This aims to reduce electricity use during the time of day when power use peaks, such as winter mornings or evenings when temperatures are often at their lowest, or late summer afternoons when the temperatures are the highest.

The idea behind this is to shift energy usage away from the times when demand is highest. Doing so could save the cooperative and its members significant money over time by keeping the wholesale power costs low and stable. This is voluntary, and benefits all members.

When do peak alerts occur?

Peak alerts typically occur in the warmest summer afternoons, usually between hours of 2 and 6 p.m. During the months of June, July, and August, there will be a maximum of nine peak energy events, with no more than four in a given month. In the winter, peak alerts happen between the hours of 5 and 8 p.m.

How can I help during peak times?

Members are encouraged to avoid using appliances, adjust their thermostat, and turn off unnecessary items when a Peak Alert is issued.

Max Gen Event (Energy Emergency Alert)

Riverland Energy Cooperative has a progressive series of emergency procedures that may be used when operating reserves drop below specified levels. These procedures are designed to protect the reliability of the electric system as a whole and prevent an uncontrolled system-wide outage.

Per Midcontinent Independent System Operators (MISO) requirements, the grid operator is required to declare an emergency alert, called a Max Gen Alert, when system frequency cannot be maintained above certain levels and durations.

When conditions warrant, MISO will instruct all power providers to begin shedding load in order to align the demand for electricity with the available power supply. We may then be required to rotate outages to help preserve the reliability of the system as a whole.

Here are some things you should know:

- All Riverland Energy members should assume their power could go out without advance warning. Efforts by the cooperative will be made to provide advance notice, when possible. Once notified by MISO to shed load, the cooperative is obligated to respond within minutes; therefore, advanced notice to members will be a challenge.
- Because this event is an emergency order from MISO based on a shortfall of available electricity, Riverland may not have the information necessary to notify members in advance of power disruption nor have the knowledge of how long the event may last.
- Riverland Energy Cooperative will make every effort to prioritize continuity of service to members so that load shed events will impact the fewest homes and businesses as conditions allow.
- In extreme emergencies, Riverland may be required to curtail a large amount of load for an extended period of time. In these instances, and when operationally possible, Riverland will attempt to rotate outages throughout our system in an equitable manner so that all members share in the outage and no single area is out for an extended period of time, unless conditions prevent such action.
- **Residential members dependent on electric-powered medical equipment are encouraged to have a reliable back-up plan in the event electricity is curtailed. It is important to note that these members are not excluded from controlled outages and may lose power during a load shed event. Anyone who depends on electricity for life-sustaining equipment should have a back-up plan in place for a reliable alternative source of electrical power.**

While the co-op may not control the issues or conditions that create a load shed event, we will do everything in our power to restore electricity when we are able to safely do so. In addition, we will work to keep our members informed of the situation through our website, through social media, and by direct communications with you.

PEAK ALERTS: Notice of Peak Alerts are typically posted on the website and our Facebook page. Peak Alerts are also broadcast on local radio stations.

MAX GEN EVENT: We intend to send out an email and text message to all who have that information on their account, as well as our website, social media, and the local radio stations. Please make sure we have your email address on file as well as a cell phone number listed for texting. You can sign up for this information through SmartHub, or call our office and we can make sure we get that information.

PEAK ALERT!

Due to high demand on the regional grid, please shift flexible electricity use until after 6 p.m.



How can I conserve electricity?

- Turn up thermostat. We recommend 78 degrees or warmer – especially if no one is home.
- Leave home to run errands.
- Run the dishwasher after 6 p.m.; open the door to let dishes air dry.
- Do laundry before or after the Peak Alert and hang up clothes to air dry. Use cold water when you wash clothes.
- Use the microwave or grill instead of the oven to cook; go on a picnic for dinner.
- Find a new book or magazine to read instead of watching TV.
- Break out the board games instead of playing video games.



MAXIMUM GENERATION EVENT

Electricity supplies are critical. Please reduce all non-essential electricity use as soon as possible.

Peak Alert will be issued when energy use is expected to be very high. It does not mean there is a shortage of power, but means we can possibly avoid significant costs. Avoid using appliances, adjust your thermostat, and turn off unnecessary items.

Max Gen Alert will be issued when we are informed by MISO to reduce energy use due to high grid stress. A rolling blackout could eventually occur and may happen without advanced notice during this alert. Reduce all unnecessary usage.

Use backup generators safely



Does your household or small business run critical electric equipment that requires backup in the event of an outage? Consider a backup generator for emergencies. However, never directly connect a standby generator to household wiring. Make sure your generator is properly grounded and kept dry.

Portable Generators should be kept in a well-ventilated area outside the home. Make sure it's out and away from your garage, doors, windows, and vents. The carbon monoxide generated is deadly. Use a heavy-duty extension cord to connect electric appliances to the outlet on the generator. Do not overload the generator. Start the generator first before connecting appliances.

Stationary Generators are hardwired and should be installed by a professional.



STUDENTS LEARN ABOUT SAFETY

Riverland Energy Cooperative’s linemen had the opportunity to teach the importance of respecting electricity during Electrical Safety Month in May. This year, Riverland Energy traveled to 24 schools in our area, teaching safety to over 1,600 students.

An electrical safety tabletop demonstration was used to illustrate the hazards of working and playing near power lines. The linemen teach kids the dangers of flying a kite or climbing a tree around power lines, what to do if their school bus comes in contact with a power line, the dangers of digging into underground lines, and to stay away from electrical substations.

The students also get to see the tools the linemen use as well as the personal protective equipment including a work belt and insulated safety gloves and sleeves.



PETE BOOS RETIRES AFTER 34 YEARS

Line Foreman Pete Boos retires on July 5 after 34 years of service to Riverland Energy Cooperative. Pete began his career at the former Trempealeau Electric Cooperative on September 6, 1988, as a lineman. Since February 14, 2020, he has been the line foreman at the Arcadia branch.

RECYCLING DRIVE A BIG SUCCESS

A steady stream of vehicles full of electronics and appliances came by each of our drop-off locations on May 24–26 to be recycled. Riverland Energy teamed up with Dynamic Lifecycle Innovations to put on the event that filled six semi loads of appliances and electronics.

SUMMER SHIFT: SMALL STEPS FOR SAVINGS

When members save energy, they tend to save money. However, there is always something in our homes using electricity—whether to cool the home, turn on the lights, or run appliances. While using electricity is inevitable, HOW members choose to use it can be impactful.



The goal of the Summer Shift program is to shift non-essential electricity use to before 11 a.m. or after 7 p.m., June through August. These are times when electricity use is not at its peak and, therefore, is not as expensive. So, how does Summer Shift work?

If a member shifts their electricity use, they may not necessarily save energy. They could use the same amount of electricity, but at a different time of the day. That is still beneficial because it means the cooperative's wholesale power provider—Dairyland Power Cooperative—did not have to purchase as much power when electricity costs were more expensive. When the cooperative saves, so do members.

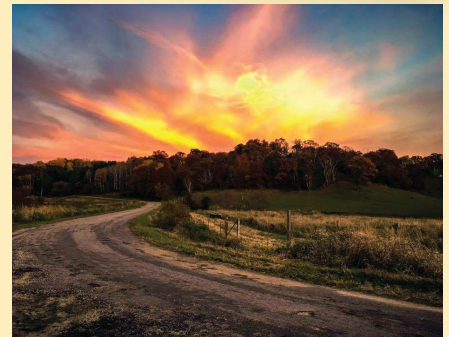
